Local Bike Doctor Service

The Bike Doctor comes every Friday morning at 9am until around 5pm (if work demands are sufficient). He is NOT visiting on the third Thursday of the month until demand increases.

Where is he?

The bike doctor works under the bike shed between the Kennedy Institute and the BDI, see map below.

WHAT TO DO?

A sign-up sheet can be found at the Richard Doll Building on the Old Road Campus.at 12pm the day before the visit.

It is opposite the Wellcome Centre for Human Genetics

So, the sign-up sheet goes out at 12 noon on the Wednesday before the Thursday visit, and at 12 noon on the Thursday before the Friday visit. When signing up, it is a good idea to take a working pen and possibly get there a bit earlier to guarantee getting on the list. He is very popular and officially only fixes 11 bikes per day, although he will do more if he has time so it is worth putting your name on the sheet anyway.

The bike doctor comes around just after 9am on the day. You need to bring your University card and bike as early as you can in the morning. You will then pick up your repaired bike later that day, paying for any work.

If you have a need for specific parts (he brings standard brake blocks/tyres/inner tubes etc), you can e-mail him before Friday on omcr@btinternet.com

COST

The University will pay the labour for the repairs on University staff's own bikes. Staff means a Bod (University) card that does not have the word "post/graduate" on it. If your Bod card says post/graduate and you do paid work for the University, you will be counted as staff so long as you can produce a payslip so the bike doctor can take a note of the payslip number. NB. Stipent/scholarship does not count as staff/payslip.


This scheme does not cover Oxford University Hospitals Trust staff cards (the light blue NHS ones).
